Privacy Policy

Paragon Revenue Group takes the privacy of patient data storage and collection seriously. It is important to our company that you understand your privacy rights and the manner in which we may use your personal information.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information is data that can be used to identify or contact a single person. You may be asked to provide your personal information anytime you are in contact with a representative of Paragon Revenue Group. Paragon Revenue Group may share this personal information with representatives within the company in a manner consistent with this privacy policy. You are not required to provide the personal information that we have requested, however, failure to do so may keep our representatives from being able to assist you with your questions or speak with you about your account. The questions that we may ask of you are intended to provide you with the highest level of security and protection of your Personal Health Information and mitigate the possibility of any sharing of unauthorized PHI and adhere to your privacy under HIPAA. As a business associate of the hospital where your bill may reside, we are legally bound to handle patient data in a way that satisfies the HIPAA POLICY.

Personal Information Collected

Paragon Revenue Group may collect a variety of information, including your name, last 4 digits of SSN, birthdate, medical information, insurance information, mailing address, phone number, zip code, email address, contact preferences, and credit card information.

How we use your personal information

We may use your personal information, including date of birth, to verify identity, assist with identification of responsible parties before speaking about the account in question.

We may also use personal information for internal purposes such as auditing, data analysis, and related to ensure that the account holders information is accurate.

It may be necessary – by law, legal process, litigation, and/or requests from public and governmental authorities within your state or country – for Paragon Revenue Group to disclose your personal information. We may also disclose information about you if we determine that for purposes of national security, law enforcement, or other issues of public importance, disclosure is necessary or appropriate.

Data Security

Paragon Revenue Group takes the security of your personal information very seriously. Paragon Revenue Group protects your personal information during transit using encryption such as Transport Layer Security (TLS). When your personal data is stored by Paragon Revenue Group, we use computer systems with limited access housed in facilities using physical security measures such as key-code encryption methods.
